## How to participate in Christmas Bird Count Feeder Count: Sunday, Jan. 2, 2022

1. Pick a time in the day to watch your feeder/backyard (it can be as little as 15 minutes or a few hours).
2. Record the Weather Conditions and area description.
3. Tally the number of birds for each species you see and enter them in the Rainier CBC Checklist. If you have a species that is not on the checklist, please enter it in the 'Other Species Seen' section on the information cover sheet.

**NOTE:** It is important that you don't double count your birds. For example, in the morning if you have six juncos at your feeder and in the afternoon, you have the same group return, you will only enter 6 juncos total. If you know they are a different flock of Juncos, you can count them.

4. Record your hours of birding.
5. Join and share your results at our online Rainier Audubon CBC Celebration Sun, Jan 2, 2022, 6:00 PM - 7:00 PM (PST)
